Chelsea Education Foundation (CEF) is a non-profit organization that provides funding for a wide spectrum of educational activities benefiting the students of Chelsea, Michigan. Funds raised through endowments and events are managed by local investment professionals and distributed to recipients by the CEF board. The Community Foundation for Southeastern Michigan and Edward Jones provides assistance to ensure we are maximizing our investments.

In 1990, the Chelsea Education Foundation was founded by Joe Piasecki, then superintendent of the Chelsea School District. The goal of the foundation was to provide a link between school, business and community to strengthen Chelsea's future. Thanks to strong community support and several significant endowments, the Foundation grew steadily and in 1999 was registered as a 501(c)3 non-profit corporation. Since its beginning, over 150 Volunteers from the Chelsea community have served one to three year terms on the CEF Board.

Many school board members, administrators, and student representatives alongside countless others have donated time, energy, resources, and services throughout its 30 year existence.

Dear Chelsea Community

As we recently shared in the "2019 CEF Reflection" newsletter, gratitude helps you grow and expand. In 2019, the generous support of Chelsea community members and businesses helped CEF continue to grow and expand our reach.

During fiscal year 2018 -2019, we provided 26 scholarships for students totaling \$25,500. We provided \$31,997 to renovate the South Creek Media Center. We awarded 30 grants to support projects, materials, trips and learning opportunities for students and staff. CEF collaborated with the Educational Foundation of Dexter (EFD) to host our first annual Rivalry Match, a cooperative fundraising event. This collaboration was recognized by the Michigan Education Foundation and both the CEF and EFD were invited to Okemos to present the details of the joint Rivalry Match fundraiser.

A frequently used quote from Maya Angelou that goes like this: "I have great respect for the past. If you don't know where you've come from, you don't know where you're going." As we move into our 30th year of serving the Chelsea School District, it is with great pride and humility that we carry on the vision of Joe Piasecki, the founder of Chelsea Community Foundation. We want to make the schools better for our kids by providing grants to teachers to enhance the educational experience of each child and scholarships to graduating seniors. 
