Fundraising began **August 19, 2025**, in anticipation of an epic showdown at the Chelsea vs. Dexter football game on **September 26, 2025**, at Al Ritt Stadium in Dexter. Since its debut in 2019, when it raised an impressive \$10,000, the Rivalry Match has become a hallmark of community spirit and generosity. After a brief hiatus in 2020, the event roared back in 2021 with \$45,000 raised, followed by a record-breaking \$98,000 in 2022. In 2023, the event generated \$41,000, and in 2024, \$46,244 was raised for local educational programs.

To date, the Rivalry Match has generated an extraordinary **\$240,234** in support of teacher-authored grants, and district-wide initiatives. EFD claimed victory in 2019, 2023, and 2024, while Chelsea led the fundraising in 2021 and 2022.

"This year, we're ready for round six!" says **Nicole Rouech**, President of the Educational Foundation of Dexter. "We're excited to continue this tradition and see how much more we can raise for our schools. No matter which foundation comes out on top, our students are always the true winners."

Amy Forehand, President of the Chelsea Education Foundation, shares that enthusiasm: "The Rivalry Match has become such an essential part of our fundraising efforts. It's all about coming together as a community to provide the resources our students and educators need to succeed."

This event isn't just about competition, it's about collaboration, unity, and making a lasting impact. The partnership between CEF and EFD is a shining example of how neighboring communities can come together to support education and empower the next generation.
